Example: Too much of a good thing: Thomas Chittenden, governor of Vermont

Example: Elijah Galusha – knew he was born in Vermont and died in Caldwell County KY, but learned from this affidavit that he had been in Amherst county Virginia in the fall of 1787 as he attended the wedding of Thomas Gregory and Sally Staples. [this is from the Revolutionary War Pension records of Sally Gregory/Thomas Gregory found in a Caldwell County KY affidavit]. I learn that's he's 89 years old when he's giving this information in 1847. Also 26 April 1847 another direct ancestor, David F Bigham, age 82 gave testimony that he was also at the same wedding. The problem is that both of these guys are 20-30 years younger than they're saying they are!! What are the facts?
