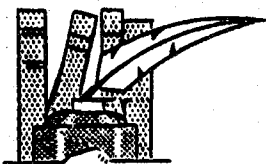


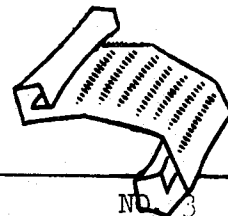

TOOLS FOR RESEARCH:

MAURY COUNTY, TENNESSEE MARRIAGE RECORDS 1807-1837, compiled by Virginia Wood Alexander and Rose Harris Priest, may be ordered from Alexander-Priest, 903 Myers Ave., Columbia, Tennessee for \$7.50 per copy. The 186 pages contain over 3200 marriages and the work is indexed. The licenses were copied from Marriage Book I. Bonds were copied from original bonds and are not recorded in the license book.

RECORDS OF ATTAKAPAS DISTRICT, LOUISIANA 1739-1811 (comprising the present parishes of St. Martin, St. Mary, Lafayette, Vermilion, and Iberia) has been edited by Mary Elizabeth Sanders, P. O. Box 1864, Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Price is \$4.75 postpaid.

Plans are under way for the compilation of a master index of New York State source material, to be collected and deposited at Fenimore House in Coopers-town. This index is designed to bring together in a unit all the records of one name, and to include census records, cemetery inscriptions, church records (baptisms, marriages and burials), family and Bible records, probate records, and unrecorded deeds.

PETITION TO ORGANIZE A COMPANY OF RIFLEMEN IN ROGERSVILLE
(HAWKINS COUNTY), TENNESSEE JULY 30, 1806

To the honourable The Senators & Representatives of the State of
Tennessee in Session

The petition of the subscribers, inhabitants of Rogersville & it's
vicinity in the county of Hawkins, respectfully sheweth That whereas the
officers of the Hawkins volunteer troop having lately resigned and no elec-
tion taken place forfilling the vacancies thereby occasioned (pursuant to
the writ of election issued by the Colonel Commandant for that purpose.
The muster ground of the company to which your petitioners belong being
several miles distant from this place, and the number of men within the
bounds of said company sufficiently large to admit of a division being made
And your petitioners being desirous of having themselves regularly formed
into a volunteer company of Riflemen to be Styled the Hawkins Rangers have
Draughted this their petition with a view of your authorizing the holding
an election for officers from amongst their body to command said company
also authorizing said company to make choice of their own uniforms, & to
fix on the day & place of holding their muster and that the fines which may
be collected from Delinquents be appropriated to the purchase of musical
Instruments & colours for the use of Said company and the payment of musi-
cians etc which their officers may employ etc etc

PETITION OF PERSONS LIVING IN THE CONGRESSIONAL RESERVATION
ASKING THE LEGISLATURE FOR RELIEF -1812

State of Tennessee (To the honorable the Senate
and House of Representatives

Whereas we your constituents being composed of emigrants from almost every part of the united States, who has concentrated in the section of country commonly called, the Congressional Reservation. With a view of procuring each to our selves a small track or parcel of Land sufficient to raise a support for our selves, and families; to which design a few of us has been so fortunate as to succeed; others took leases; and a large proportion of us, some through poverty, having expended of our money in moving here, and not being able to retreat; others seeing the precarious situation as to Land Titles; and the extravagant rates at which it sold; being forced to raise a support for our families, we deemed it proper to settle on vacant, or unappropriated Lands. In hopeful expectation that provisions would be made by which it would be in our powers to become the rightful owners each of us of a small quantity. Flattering ourselves with those vain Ideas, some of us has made valuable improvements, and are in a situation to live comfortably; could we remain unmolested, or purchase the Land which we now occupy at a moderate rate. In this we find our hopes are vanquished; and are succeeded by the most gloomy clouds of despair. As we find that the Legislature of North Carolina, who has ever distinguished her self for her zeal, as to promoting Speculation; In her superiority of wisdom, has deemed it expedient to extend her authority so far as to authorize that state to perfect Titles to the unappropriated Lands which we now occupy. Which resolution was carried into effect so far as was in the power of that Judicious State to proceed. But fortunately for us our Legislator in Session in 1812 was not unmindful of the common interests of their constituents. They passed a Law forbidding the North Carolina claims being carried into effect in this State; under certain penalties therein prescribed. Which has prevented the operation of the Resolution of North Carolina for a season. Now it appears that those Gentlemen who are interested in the establishment of the Claims desired, pursuant to the authority of North Carolina, has pronounced our Law of 1812, as unconstitutional. Should, the Law above alluded to of 1812 be by you considered as unconstitutional, we expect of course you will repeal, or disannul it. Should this be the case; if the Claims of North Carolina is carried into effect and no farther provisions made by you for us, in what situation shall we be? Will not the claimants under the authority of North Carolina have in their power to have their own claims established, and reject us at any time they may think proper? The situation of our affairs at the present period bares a gloomy aspect. We are involved in war with a numerous and powerful nation; Our coasts are invaded by our tyrannical foe. The unrelenting Savages has become formidable and are butchering our countrymen. and spreading their carnages on our extensive frontiers. Do we not compose a part of the militia the most permanent Bulwark of our empire? Are we not as liable to be called into actual (combat) as any other band of our (---)? Are we not threatened by the hostile Creeks, and much exposed to their fury should they put their threats in practice being the frontier Country, and bounded by extensive and uninhabited deserts. What then could be our feelings to shoulder our muskets to march towards the frozen north, or to the Creek Nation to face our bloody foes; not knowing what might be our fate. Leaving our tender wives and helpless infants in this exposed situation; Destitute

of any permanent or stated place of residence; Not knowing but what they are rejected and turned out of doors in a few hours after our departure, and left destitute of any place to shelter them from the inclemency of the weather; or anyone to provide for or protect them. We feel it our duty to support our government, we also wish our government to protect us. We are as willing to fight in defence of our country's rights as any soldiers on the Continent. We your constituents firmly confiding in your zeal, and patriotism, as you was depending on us previous to your respective elections, we are depending on you. As in you we have reposed the utmost confidence, in the important grounds for a controversy between the States of North Carolina and Tennessee with respect to the right to perfect titles to the Lands above mentioned; we should deem it very unjust for those gentlemen who has obtained grants for Lands derived from the authority of North Carolina as above stated to be vested with full power and authority to reject us and enjoy the benefits deriving from our labour untill this controversy terminates. We wish the business fairly investigated at the termination of which Should it be in the favour of North Carolina we most humbly submit Should the North Carolina claims be sanctioned by you We your petitioners humbly solicit your attention towards us. Have we not settled this country under great disadvantage, having our provisions to carry a considerable distance? have we not opened roads in almost every direction? These with many other difficulties and disadvantages we have undergone and to what purpose? was it not to improve our uncultivated forests, for the devouring swarm of speculators to inherit the open roads and to make the country comfortable and convenient for others. Can there be any appearance of justice in our being dispossesst, without any compensation for our labour, or even thanks for our toil? Was our improvements the labour of their hands, or made by the sweat of their brows? had they any colour of Claim to the Land when those improvements was made? we presume not.

We your petitioners do consider that we are justily entitled to the benefits of our Labour for a term of years equal to a common Leas, from and after those claimants has, or may obtain their titles, or a reasonable compensation for our Labour; as by such measures being taken, we should be limited to a certain period and have opportunity of providing places to shelter our selves, and families.

Thus having given you a brief statement of our situation, We humbly submit our cause to your Consideration; hoping, and trusting, that in this, and all other business which may come under your consideration, you will act in a manner that will crown you with honour, and be reciprocally advantageous to the community at large.

May your minds be emulated by that virtuous zeal, and firmness, which ever directed the steps of our celebrated Washington, and keep you like him in the unerring paths of virtue.
