



BOOK REVIEWS

THE HERALDRY OF THE CINQUE PORTS by Geoffrey Williams (1971),
192 pages, hard cover, index. Order from Charles E. Tuttle
Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$6.50

Inasmuch as England had no Royal Navy around the year 1200, five ports were established in southeast England, with certain obligations to the Crown. Owners of ships in these Cinque Ports were jointly responsible for the provision of up to 57 ships, and their crews, for a maximum of 15 days in any one year, at their expense. After that the King was held responsible for provisioning the crews. When the Heraldry of the Ports began cannot be confirmed, however, each port and each ship had its own seal or grant of arms. The earliest known seal of Dover was around 1180. This book gives detailed descriptions and pictures of arms or seals with explanations as to their use.

SACO VALLEY SETTLEMENTS AND FAMILIES by G. T. Ridlon, Sr. (1895), 1250 pages, hard cover, index. Reprinted 1969 by Charles E. Tuttle Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$17.50.

Gleanings of genealogical notes, collected over a period of twenty-five years, from records of the oldest inhabitants of the Saco Valley area, make this a tremendous genealogy. Each settlement is covered. Maps show who lived on certain tracts of land. There are names of 15,000 persons, many portraits, place views and 126 authentic genealogies. Church records, rural life and character, customs and quaint devices are graphically and interestingly written.

HERALDRY EXPLAINED by Arthur Charles Fox-Davies (1906), 126 pages, hard cover, index. Reprinted 1971 by Charles E. Tuttle Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$4.50.

This excellent little book has often been recommended by booksellers for the beginner on this subject. Marks of difference and distinction, details and importance of the shield, the use of crest coronets are pictured and explained. The novice should have no difficulty in learning how to prove a right to arms, how to secure a coat of arms and how it should be used.

THE "MARY AND JOHN" A STORY OF THE FOUNDING OF DORCHESTER, MASSACHUSETTS, 1630 by Maude Pinney Kuhns (1971), 254 pages, hard cover, index. Order from Charles E. Tuttle Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$12.00.

The ship, "Mary and John", left Plymouth, England on March 20, 1630 with 140 passengers. The immigrants were from Dorchester, England and they gave this name to their first settlement and to other settlements in America as they and their descendants scattered. This book is deeply historical, a biographical beacon and a genealogical landmark. There are 56 ancestral charts listed and here we find the names of many famous men of our American heritage. Many pages record the names, dates and marriages of entire families thus giving more information than is normally found on a chart.

ALCORN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI CEMETERY RECORDS compiled by Thomas P. Hughes, Jr., and Jewel B. Standefer (1971), 239 pages, soft cover, index. Order from The Tennessee Genealogical Society, P. O. Box 111249, Memphis, Tennessee 38111-1249

Alcorn County was formed April 15, 1870, when Old Tishomingo County was divided into three counties. At that time, eighty-six sections of land taken from Tippah and Prentiss Counties were added to Alcorn.

The earliest birth date recorded in this book is of Henry Robinson, born in Augusta County, Virginia in 1773. Eighty cemeteries are listed and in each burials are alphabetized. Locations of cemeteries are given where possible.

BIBLE RECORDS OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND 1616-1969 and Baptismal and Marriage Records, 1855-1866, Zion United Methodist Church, Cambridge, Maryland, compiled by Nellie M. Marshall (1971), 120 pages, 8½x11, soft cover, index. Order from the publisher, Dorchester County Historical Society, "Meredith House", P. O. Box 361, Cambridge, Maryland 21613. \$10.00.

Bible and Church records serve a useful purpose in establishing genealogical data. Approximately 2900 names are listed in this book. The earliest records noted were of William Mitchell and John Mitchell born in Edinborough, Scotland, the latter part of the 16th century; the latest date recorded was 1968.

1830 CENSUS WEST TENNESSEE transcribed and indexed by Byron Sistler, (1971), 213 pages, hard cover. Order from Byron Sistler and Associates, 1626 Washington Street, Evanston, Illinois 60202. \$23.00.

This census of Western Tennessee, along with the Middle and Eastern Tennessee census books by the same compiler concludes the 1830 census of the entire state. West Tennessee, in 1830, was comprised of Carroll, Dickson, Dyer, Fayette, Gibson, Giles, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Henderson, Henry, Hickman, Humphreys, Lawrence, Madison, McNairy, Montgomery, Obion, Perry, Shelby, Tipton, Wayne and Weakley Counties. This area now includes Benton, Chester, Crockett, Decatur, Houston, Lake, Lauderdale and Lewis Counties. A map dating from about 1823, outlining the boundaries of the first 24 counties is included.

HISTORY OF THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBURY in the County of Addison, Vermont, by Samuel Swift (1859), reprinted 1971, 454 pages, index, hard cover. Order from Charles E. Tuttle Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$12.50.

The Historical Society of Middlebury, wishing to preserve the early history of its area, chose Samuel Swift, a far-seeing historian, to write this book.

He has breathed life into a body of facts and statistics and acquaints the reader with the character of many of the first settlers and prominent citizens. The Indian Wars, the French Settlement, The Revolutionary War and the Agricultural Society of the post war period are covered along with the names of the people who were involved.

The author takes a small town of New England and pictures the early life from which sprang the qualities of character which fashioned our nation.

THE YANKEE PIONEERS, A Saga of Courage, by Samuel B. Pettengill (1971), 175 pages, 5x7½, hard cover. Order from Charles E. Tuttle Company, Rutland, Vermont 05701. \$5.00.

This is a gripping story of the hardy people who took New England from the wilderness. Just to read the table of contents or the list of illustrations is a trip into the past. If one has sat by the side of an elderly person and heard the stories of pioneer days he can vividly recall through this little book the events, trials and tribulations of worthy ancestors who helped make America.

HOPKINS COUNTY KENTUCKY WILLS 1807-1829, COURT ORDERS July 1815-December 1815, copied by Mrs. Evelyn M. Cox and prepared for distribution by Mrs. Cox and Mrs. Lala F. McCulley (1961), 106 pages, index, loose leaf binder. Order from Hopkins County Genealogical Society, P. O. Box 51, Madisonville, Kentucky 42431. \$10.00.

Hopkins County in the western part of Kentucky was established in 1808. The publication consists of Will Books One and Two and part of Minute Book Three. The Will Books record estate settlements, guardianships and some marriages.

OCONEE HILL CEMETERY edited by Charlotte Thomas Marshall for Athens Historical Society, Athens, Georgia (1971), 161 pages, two indexes, soft cover, 8½x11. Order from Mrs. George O. Marshall, Jr., 402 Riverview Road, Athens, Georgia 30601. \$6.50.

Fire destroyed the records of interments in this cemetery prior to 1897. This compilation was an effort to replace as many records as possible. Although the cemetery was opened in 1856 there are older tombstones due to removals from the original town cemetery and family burying grounds. Names which have been recorded since 1897 are in a separate index. A notes section amplifies some of the inscriptions. A map showing each lot is included.

THE TANSILL SECTION OF THE TANSILL, BENDER, CALLIAN, HOLMEAD, AND OTHER EARLY AMERICAN FAMILIES, by Commander Xavier Bender Tansill, USNR (ret) (1971), 8½x11, soft cover, 117 pages. Order from the author, 8708 First Avenue, Silver Spring, Maryland 20910. No price listed.

Photographs from which the xeroxed pictures shown herein were made, appear in the copies of these volumes which include all four sections, on file in the Library of Congress, National Archives, DAR and National Genealogical Society Libraries. Commander Tansill has compiled a notable list of ancestors.

ROSTER OF SOLDIERS AND PATRIOTS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION BURIED IN INDIANA, Volume II, compiled by Mrs. Roscoe C. O'Byrne. Published by Indiana Daughters of the American Revolution (1966), 170 pages, hard cover, alphabetized. Order from Mrs. Albert E. Crayden, Indiana Society D A R, Ramsey, Indiana 47166. \$6.00.

In this volume will be found data on over 350 soldiers and patriots, whose records have been located since the publication of the first Roster, Volume I (\$12.50). Data include the birth, and death dates, when and to whom married, children with their birthdates, service record and proof. Additional information on some of the soldiers listed in Volume I and an index of Volume I giving names and counties are included.

THE MILLION-AIRES (HEIRS) by Carl N. Hayes (1971), 8½x11, soft cover, 102 pages. Order from the author, Route 1, Chuckey, Tennessee 37641. \$6.00.

Edward Million and Mary White were married August 11, 1777 in Rockingham, Virginia. They were in Washington County, Tennessee by 1780. To this union eight children were born. This is a typical pioneer family which has survived the hardships common to all early settlers, the Indian Wars, the Civil War, disease, hunger and loneliness to become a part of the lift stream of the nation. Descendants have moved onward to the west and southwest.

GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE CEMETERIES compiled by Buford Reynolds (1971), 8½x11, soft cover, 501 pages. Order from Carl N. Hayes, Route 1, Chuckey, Tennessee 37641. \$20.00

Mr. Reynolds has done a monumental work in registering the graves in Greene County, with tombstones. Naming the cemeteries in which they were found, he includes directions as to how to reach them. The unmarked identifiable graves have been noted. Tombstones in each cemetery are alphabetized.

SCOTCH-IRISH MIGRATION TO SOUTH CAROLINA, 1772 by Jean Stephenson (1971), hard back, 140 pages, index. Order from Miss Thekla G. Stephan, 5303 14th St. N.W., Washington, D. C. 20011. \$6.75.

This volume tells briefly the story of conditions in Ireland in 1772 that led to a migration to South Carolina, and of the party that came to South Carolina that year under the guidance of the Rev. William Martin. The names of the 468 persons who applied for land and the acreage granted to each are given. Land surveys have been identified for 80% of these people, with water courses mentioned, determining where they settled. The names of previous settlers on lands adjoining "The Martin Party" are listed. Anyone tracing South Carolina-Scotch-Irish ancestors will find the volume helpful.

DESCENDANTS OF HENRY HARRISON BOON, including Partial Histories on Curtner and Burgess Families, by Merritt Anderson Boon (1971), 8½x11, soft cover, 101 pages, index. Order from the author, Box 1406, Clemson, South Carolina 29631. \$5.00.

This family story is the result of an attempt to prove a relationship with Daniel Boone. The intrigued author, though not proving the relationship, did put the results of his research into a family history. Henry Harrison Boon, born 1819, married Malinda Curtner, born 1832, on September 9, 1850 in Union City, Tennessee. They moved to Pemiscott County, Missouri in 1873. Both are buried in the Baptist Churchyard in Hayward, Missouri. Write the author so that your family can be included in his proposed new edition.

1850 FEDERAL CENSUS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, transcribed, indexed and published by Ann Evans Alley and Ursula Smith Beach (1971), 293 pages, 8½x11, soft cover. Order from Ann E. Alley, Route One, Box 76, Adams, Tennessee 37010. \$10.00.

The 1850 Federal Census is the first in which each member of the household was listed. The individual's age, sex, color, and place of birth, as well as the occupation of each male over 15 years of age is given for the first time. This census is especially valuable to genealogists. The book is well organized and easily used.


