

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

PETITIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF TENNESSEE Abstracted from Tennessee State Library and Archives Microfilm Legislative Petitions 1799-1801, Roll No. 1 (Continued from Spring issue)

In our continuing effort to provide readers with names of early Tennesseans, we are abstracting the petitions for 1799 through 1803. We hope the signers of these petitions provide an alternative to an early census as Tennessee does not have an 1800 or 1810 census, and most of the 1820 census for East Tennessee was lost. Every effort has been made to read the names correctly; however, due to fading ink, ink blots, smudged signatures and very poor handwriting in some instances, some names were very difficult or impossible to read. Also, when the petitions were assembled, numbered and laminated together at the State Archives, errors were made and some petitions now differ from the originals. (Abstracts of petitions for the years 1805 through 1813 have been published in "ANSEARCHIN'" NEWS since 1985, Vol. 32.)

1-1-1799 Petition of inhabitants of Capt HARPOLES" Militia Company to divide Sumner County..."beginning at a point on the Kentucky or Provincial line, from which a due South Course will strike the head of the main fork of Rockey Creek and down the Same to its confluence with Cumberland River, and from thence a South, South East course to the Indian Boundary"...such a division will be important to most inhabitants "as it will be a means of quelling several parties and factions which almost distract said county, and without which your Petitioners and others will be left in a State of Anarchy, as many of them live upwards of seventy miles from the place of holding Courts, Elections and General Musters." 2-1-1799 Inhabitants of Jefferson Co believe that the bounds between Cock[e] Co and the foot of Cumberland Mountain or the indian boundary line is not sufficient for three counties and that nature has formed it for two and no more. Therefore they petition that no new county be made in that area but that part of Grainger Co which lies next to Jefferson be added to it as far as the top of Clinch Mountain. They also ask for a Superior Court district between that of Washington and Hamilton Cos. Signed by: (9 pages)

8-1-1799-5a Petition of John WALLACE [see Petition 8-1-1799]. (2 pages)

9-1-1799 Petition of the "undersigned" who have a grievance against the Militia Law where "it gives Exclusive privilledge to one Sect or Denomenation of

people in preferance to others which we think is contrery to the true intent and meaning of the Constitution of this State"...the complaint concerns the number of days of duty required for some men, aged 18 to 45, but excused for Quakers and "nonresistants." They ask for repeal of a law which put part of Greene Co into Cocke Co. They ask for a law requiring inspection of flour and tobacco; they ask for clarification of the road law and a new law "to prohibit frad and Decit with respect to notes and bonds given to any parson...removing out of the county..."

[No list of names follows this entangled petition, but it appears to be from Greene Co. Ed.] (4 pages)

10-1-1799 Petition of Hezekiah BALCH...he has almost finished the building of Greenville College and in a few weeks will begin teaching...asks for exemption from military duty and working on the roads for teachers and scholars of the college. Greene Co, 23 Sep 1799. (3 pages)

11-1-1799 Petition of inhabitants of Blount Co to open a land office to enter lands south of French Broad between the rivers Tennessee & Big Pigeon. Signers were [8 or 10 names impossible to read]: In Senate 4 Jan 1799. (3 pages)

Ms. Eichman recently found a clipping in an old Bible concerning the family of her great grandfather, William Cage HALE, who died 28 Feb 1897 at the age of 81 years and 1 month. The article was printed in a Howard Co AR newspaper copied from a newspaper in Union City, Obion Co TN.

"It is doubtful if there is a county in Tennessee that contains a family that will equal in length of days the Hales to this county. When we consider the number of this family their ages make a most remarkable showing. They are as follows: Emma, 85; Betsy, 84; William, 80 years and 11 months; Wilson, 77 years and 5 months; Sally, 72 years and 7 months; John 69 years and 4 months; Catherine, 63 years and 6 months; Eliza, 61 years and 11 months. The father of this family was Squire Cage Hale, who was one of the pioneers of this county, who died before the late war. - Union City (Tenn.) Commercial. The 80-year old "William" mentioned in the above is our own "Uncle William Hale", whom every Corinthian knows. Although he has been suffering of late from the grippe, he is usually hale and hearty, making the finest appearance on horseback of all the cavaliers of this community."

The obituary of William C. Hale was difficult to read but the following information was gleaned from it. He died at Mt. Pleasant at age 82, having celebrated his 81st birthday on the 8th of last January. All but two of his children were with him during his last hours. He was a faithful member of the Church of Christ.

Calvin JONES Chancellor etc came on this cause to be heard upon the petition of the parties and it appearing to the Court that in the year 1844 one James CALDWELL departed this life in Weakley County, Tennessee intestate, and it appearing to the Court that the petitioners are his only heirs at law, and it further appearing from the said petition that the said James Caldwell died seized and possessed of the lands mentioned in the petition and it appearing to the Court that the said James in his lifetime made advancements to his children of real estate which advancements were as is alledged unequal. It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the Clerk & Master take and state an account of the advancements made by said James Caldwell in his life time in real estate that he value said lands at the time the advancements were made and that he report to this or the next Term of the Court."

GENEALOGICAL ABSTRACTS REVOLUTIONARY WAR VETERANS SCRIP ACT 1852 by Margie G. Brown. 1990. Hardback,  $5\frac{1}{2}x8\frac{1}{2}$ . Full name Index & Migration Index, 526 pp. Order from author, 3005 Phyllmar Place, Oakton, VA 22124. \$60.00

Extracts of genealogical information have been taken from records relating to the Revolutionary War Scrip Act of 1852, Record Group 49, Bureau of Land Management. These records are held by the Suitland Branch of the National Archives, Suitland, MD. In March of 1852, the Act was passed by Congress to take care of all previously awarded but unsatisfied Military Land Warrants. It was this final attempt to honor the Virginia Act of 1781, that generated 1,689 files of mainly Virginia families. If the rights to the scrip were still held by descendants of the veteran, the files contain Court documents proving heirship and the relationship to the veteran. In addition to Court documents, copies of wills, depositions, Powers of Attorney and letters from lawyers and claimants are included. Names are given of the long dead veteran's grandchildren and great-grandchildren as well as places to which they migrated.

WYATT JEAN OF LINCOLN COUNTY, TENNESSEE His Descendants and some of his Siblings, 1840-1990 by [Mrs.] Royleta C. Malone. 1990. Soft back, 8½x11. No Index, 28 pp. Order from author, 1097 West Yarrow Ln., Salt Lake City, UT 84123. \$10.00

This family history contains information on the Wyatt Jean family which includes the following surnames: Bryant, Malone, Sullenger, Campbell, Maddox, Simmons, Parker, Hunter, Preston, Harris and Shaw. The family origin was Lincoln County, Tennessee but they extend to Alabama, Texas, Oklahoma and as far west as California. The book contains photo copies of documents and family photographs.

THEY CAME IN SHIPS by John Philip Colletta, Ph.D. 1989. Soft back, 52x82, 68 pp. Order from, Ancestry, Inc., Dept. SRV, P.O. Box 538, Salt Lake City, UT 84110. \$5.95 plus \$2.50 S&H.

Before the modern era everyone who came to America came on a ship. In most cases there is some kind of record of our ancestor's arrival. This excellent little handbook is a guide to obtaining this information. Chapter 1 prepares you to undertake your search. It tells you what you need to know and helps guide you to that information; also the significance of pre-1820 and post-1830 arrivals. Chapters 2 and 3 provide information on how to use the indexes and resource material available. Whether your ancestor arrived in a sailing vessel or on board a steamship, specific research strategies are presented. These strategies are summarized in a chart on pages 66 and 67 entitled "How to find your Immigrant Ancestor's Ship." The book contains many references and a good bibliography.

MUIRHEID FAMILY RECORD by Nola M. Karr. 1990. Hard back, 7x10. Indexed, 421 pp. Order from author, Rt. 1, Box 1104-MM, Port Tobacco, MD 20677. \$25.00 plus \$2.00 S&H.

This book is "a genealogy of some of the descendants of John Muirheid who immigrated from Scotland" to New Jersey in 1685. He came on the ship "Henry and Francis", along with others banished from Scotland because of their religious convictions. Information is given on twelve generations of Muirheids who descended from John. Particular emphasis is on the family of William Franklin Muirheid, son of John, who settled in Macon County Illinois in 1830. This family history is coded in such a specific manner that locating data is easy and the supplemental index with its cross reference for married women and parents of spouses is most valuable. Along with an interesting historical introduction, a section of well-reproduced family photographs is included.

HISTORY OF PACE'S FROM TIPTON COUNTY TENNESSEE VOL. 1 & VOL. 2 by William Carroll Pace. 1990. Soft back, spiral bound, 8½xll. No Index, over 300 pp per volume. Order from author, 2711 Tottingham Rd., Oklahoma City, OK 73120. \$35.00 (for 2 Vol. set)

The book begins with John Carroll Pace in 1828 (McNairy County, Tennessee) and continues through 1990 families. Documentation, copies of wills, deeds, war records, etc. are included. Copies of pages from other books, copies of original Bible records and copies of letters from other Pace members are incorporated in each volume. There is a tabbed section for each major surname researched, which are Pace, Gwinn, Austin, Baucom, Smith, Weaver and Cooper. Book Reviews (continued)

ATCHLEYS - DWELLERS IN OR NEAR AN OAK GROVE by Gearl Atchley. 1990. Soft back, 8x11. Indexed, 198 pp. Order from author, Rt. 1, Box 4, Green Forest, AR 72638. \$25.00 plus \$3.00 shipping.

The focus of the first chapter of the family history is the Joel Atchley family of Oak Grove, Arkansas. They arrived there from points east in 1841. The first American Atchley is thought to be James/John Atchley who landed in Virginia in 1666, then settled in Pennslyvania. His son Joshua lived in New Jersey but died in Loudon Co. Virginia. Joshua had five sons who fought in the Revolutionary War and migrated to Sevier Co. Tennessee, then to other parts of TN. Census records trace the movements of Joel Atchley and his family; he was born in TN, his wife Sarah in South Carolina, his two elder sons in Indiana and the younger children in Arkansas. The documents and pictures included are of very high quality and add to the interest and information of this book. Also the personal individual data of occupation, personality traits and family stories add to the total family picture.

IMMIGRATED TO TENNESSEE Chronicles of a Fowler Family by Jane Cook Hollis. 1991. Soft back, 8½x11. Full name Index, 108 pp. Order from author, 3057 Eagan Dr., Memphis, TN 38115. \$16.00

This family history traces some of the descendants of five Fowlers, four brothers and a sister, who in 1808 left their home in Sampson Co. North Carolina for the West. They left behind in North Carolina a brother and a sister whose descendants have passed down the tradition that the five westward bound Fowlers were the children of John and Hannah Sutton Fowler and the grandchildren of Daniel Fowler and Mary Jane Rollins. Generation one begins with Daniel Fowler, Revolutionary War veteran, and goes forward for eleven generations. The family group that headed West settled in Caldwell (now Trigg) Co. Kentucky, just north of the TN-KY border. Later descendants moved to other parts of Tennessee, Arkansas and Mississippi. The book is well documented with footnotes and has a numbering system that is easy to follow.

THE PARRISH FAMILY compiled by Rev. Brent L. Parrish. 1991. Hard back, 5½x8½. Full name Index, 289 pp. Order from author, P O Box 116, Sheldon, WI 54766. \$25.00

Years of research by many individuals resulted in this Parrish/Parish book. It is organized in "one giant outline." The number in front of each name indicates the generation to which that individual belongs and, whenever possible, the order of birth. The first Parrish immigrant is believed to be Edward, born ca. 1600 in Yorkshire England. The author began the book with Edward and carried the family forward to present day. Families from the following states appear to be covered: Virginia, Maryland, Ohio, Missouri, Minnesota, Nebraska, Iowa, California and others. Some allied family names are: Albright, Andrews, Belt, Dugan, Hanson, Headlee, Mendell, Peck, Ranslem, Shipman, and many others.

NORTH CAROLINA REVOLUTIONARY ARMY ACCOUNTS, SECRETARY OF STATE, TREASURER'S AND COMPTROLLER'S PAPERS - Vol. I, Vol. II, Part II by Weynette Parks Haun. 1991. Soft back, 8¹/₂x11. Full name Index, 288 pp. Order from author, 243 Argonne Dr., Durham, NC 27704. \$20.00

In the introduction the author states that the North Carolina Revolutionary Army Accounts represent one of the most perplexing sets of records in the North Carolina State Archives. To facilitate understanding, the Archives has prepared a booklet which explains why, how and by whom the records were generated. These explanations have been incorporated into this work and precede the individual volumes and books where appropriate. This book is a continuation of the same material by Ms Haun, previously published Part I, JOURNAL "A" (1988). Volume I contains the specie certificates paid into the comptroller's office by John Armstrong, Entry Taker for lands in North Carolina from 2 Apr 1784 to 20 May 1784. Volume II is a settling of accounts with the officers and soldiers as to their claims of pay, subsistence, deficiency of clothing, etc for service on the Continental Line.

<u>GREENWOOD COUNTY, KANSAS MARRIAGE RECORD BOOK I</u> by Leta Ellen Watts Harrell & Katheryn Ann Brooks Griffith. 1991. Soft back, 8½xll. Full name Index, 266 pp. Order from Relatively Searching, P O Box 146, Hamilton, KS 66853. \$20.00

Marriages from Books A, Al, B, C, and D are covered in this book including the years 1856-1895. Greenwood County is one of the original Kansas counties and was laid out in 1855. Eureka, KS was chosen county seat in 1866 replacing Janesville. Each book section begins with a listing of the names of Probate Judges, Clerks, Ministers of the Gospel and Justices of the Peace. The Book, page number, name of groom, name of the bride and the marriage date is then listed. Book Reviews (continued)

PASQUOTANK COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA COUNTY COURT MINUTES 1747 thru 1753 Book II BY Weynette Parks Haun. 1990. Soft back, 8¹/₂x11. Full name Index, 141 pp. Order from author, 243 Argonne Dr., Durham, NC 27704. \$17.50

Fortunately for genealogists everywhere, Weynette Parks Haun continues her publication of early North Carolina records. Her experience in reading such early records makes her interpretation of old laws and ancient handwriting most important, if not infallible. Material in this book includes records covering the area taken in 1777 to form Camden Co. Minutes of such early courts record all business which transpired in the county, such as recording of deeds, proving of wills, appointment for road workers and lawsuits of the citizenry.

SOME DUNCAN FAMILIES OF EASTERN TENNESSEE BEFORE 1800 by Mary Ann Dobson. 1991 Revision of 1979 version. Soft back, 8¹/₂x11. Full name Index, 292 pp. Order from author, 3148 Ridge Court, Placerville, CA 95667. \$16.00

The information in this book is a result of research in an effort to identify and separate the many Duncans in East Tennessee before 1800. The Book is divided into five sections covering the descendants of Marshall Duncan (1700-1777), Thomas Duncan (1768-1832), Joseph Duncan (c1720-??), Jeremiah Duncan (c1750-c1820) and Section V with Duncan families in the same place at the same time but without proof of how they are related to the families in Sections I-IV. The appendix contains some Bible and Family Records. The book is well documented with the names and addresses of contributing Duncan researchers at the end of each section.

THE WICKER/WHICKER FAMILY Devonshire, Virginia, North Carolina by Dr. R. F. Wicker, Jr. 1989. Hard back, 6x9. Full name Index, 331 pp. Order from, Wicker Publishing Co., 5136 Violet Bank Dr., Virginia Beach, VA 23464. \$32.50

This book is the result of forty years of research into the history of this one family. Dr. Wicker traces the name from the Devonshire area of England in the latter part of the 1400's in which each numbered individual can be referred to a prior generation's number. Each ancestry has a short biography with a list of children and their vital statistics. After listing eight generations in England, he then proceeds with the fifteen generations in the United States down to the present. He lists 601 separate individuals with their families by generational pattern.

DEED BOOKS 9, 10 and 11, AMELIA COUNTY, VIRGINIA, DEEDS 1766-1773 abstracted and compiled by Gibson Jefferson McConnaughey. 1990. Soft back, 8½x11. Indexed, 106 pp. Order from, Mid-South Publishing Co., P O Box 659, Amelia, VA 23002. \$24.50

Deed Books 9, 10 and 11 are an addition by this compiler to the Continuing Series of COLONIAL RECORDS OF AMELIA COUNTY, VIRGINIA. The earliest Deed Books date from 1735 when Amelia County was created from Prince George Co. VA and a small part of Brunswick Co. VA. In 1789 Nottoway Co. was formed from Amelia Co., therefore, these books contain pre-1789 records for presentday Nottoway Co. The clean, clear, concise format makes it easy for the researcher to locate his/her family information. Grantees and grantors are underlined, thereby, making it easier to locate one's ancestors.

MARRIAGES RECORDED IN DEKALB COUNTY TENNESSEE 1848-1900 by Jorene Washer Parsley. 1990. Soft back, 8¹/₂xll. Indexed, 328 pp. Order from author, Rt. 5, Box 43, Smithville, TN 37166. \$35.00

The sharp, clear printing of this valuable manuscript makes it an asset for descendants of this Tennessee county. In making the effort to interpret the handwriting of the marriage records, the census was studied, and families and friends were interviewed. Therefore, full names, alternate spellings and other information have been inserted occasionally for explanation and clarity. Included are three full-name indexes of the Grooms, Brides and Officiators compiled by Doris Gilbert.

FUNERAL HOME RECORDS FROM DUNKLIN CO, MO by Dunklin County Genealogical Society. Soft back, 8½x11. Alphabetized, 172 pp. Order from the Society, c/o Dunklin County Library, 226 N. Main St., Kennett, MO 63857. \$25.00

In the first section of this manuscript are the records of Baldwin Funeral Home and Emerson-Baldwin Funeral Home of Kennett, Missouri from October 21, 1919 to September 5, 1964. Lentz

Funeral Home Records of Kennett from December 2, 1929 to October 1, 1980 are in the second section. Dates of birth, death and the birthplace of the deceased are listed; plus the informant or spouse, the names of father and mother and their birthplaces. Also included is the cemetery or location of burial. Each section is alphabetized by the surname of the deceased, therefore there is no index for the mother's maiden name.

This is one volume containing all three of the books named above. Researchers who needed very early records from old Chickasaw County, Mississippi, which included parts of present Clay, Webster and Calhoun counties, were sorely hampered by the loss of early records to fire during the 1860s until these substitute records were compiled. Book I has state census records, tax assessments, etc. Book II gives land owners by township and range, Book III includes the land patents by township, range and date for Calhoun County and the Pontotoc Land District.

LEWIS OF WARNER HALL: THE HISTORY OF A FAMILY compiled by Merrow Egerton Sorley. 1991 reprint of 1935 book. Hard back,  $5\frac{1}{2}x8\frac{1}{2}$ . Indexed, 887 pp. Order from, Genealogical Publishing Co., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202-3897. \$45.00

This is the story of one John Lewis who married Elizabeth Warner, whose grandfather, Augustine Warner Sr., was the original owner of Warner Hall in Gloucester Co Virginia. Elizabeth inherited Warner Hall from her brother, Robert Warner. The purpose of this book is to trace the descendants of "Councillor" John Lewis and Elizabeth Warner through their three sons: Col. John Lewis and wife, Frances Fielding; Col. Charles Lewis and wife, Mary Howell; and Col. Robert Lewis and wife, Jane Meriwether. Additional related families are Ambler, Ball, Barret, Bowles, Bushrod, Byrd, Carter, Cobbs, Crawford, Eppes, Fauntleroy, Griffin, Isham, Jefferson, Kennon, Marshall, Piersey, Ragland, Randolph, Taliaferro, Taylor, Thompson, Walker, Washington, Willis, Woodson and Worsham. A genealogical chart of the ancestors, as well as descendants, of John and Elizabeth Warner Lewis is very helpful.

Volume I primarily lists the Swiss emigrants from Zurich at the time of the great exodus, 1734-1744. Approximately 2000 of these people are identified with information that often includes ages, family members, and place of origin. Volume II extends this listing of information of the Cantons of Bern, 1706-95, and Basel, 1734-94. The preface in each volume gives a large amount of detail on the reason for this Swiss migration to America, and the trials and difficulties encountered in the process of movement. In addition to ages of these emigrants and family members, the information often has date of birth or baptism, trade, name of wife, names of children, and destination; most of them settled in the Carolinas and Pennsylvania. The authors drew this information from original records on deposit in the state archives of Bern and Basel which includes emigration tax lists, manumission registers, orphan court records, church archives, and parish registers.
